Activity during the period	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Registration of new savio Club students was done during the month of January from 9th – 31st • The students were given orientation in their particular centres, by the teachers • The students were instructed about the rule and purpose of Savio Club. The life and activities of St. Dominic Savio was narrated to them. • Encouraged the students to have friends from different Nationalities and tribes. This is to ensure that children to start learning early how to see and treat each other like a friend. • Three new teachers were recruited for the centers of Gaudalupe and Our Lady of Assumption. • I encouraged teachers to be reporting to the centre according to the agreed time which is 1:20 Pm and departure from the centre at 5:30 Pm. And incase of any absentiseem one should report to the supervisor and if it's a long term absentiseem one should get permission from fr.Mathew. • We have procured 300 boxes biscuits and 300boxes milk on 2nd February 2024. • I have supplied nine charts of different subject to the nine centres and playing materials, 4 pieces of skipping rope and one piece of football ball to the nine centres. • The refreshments will be issued on weekend to each centre according to the number of learner in the centre. • I have plan to be visiting the centres thrice per month • I have discussed with the teachers about the story books.Since first term is more of

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		teaching the students how to read and write because most of them, they join savio club while they don't know how to write even they names. So we decided with the teachers the story books will be supplied as from second term when they know how to read.
