1.	<b>Project Name of the programme</b>	<i>Savio Club – Educational support for children</i>
2.	<b>Reporting period</b>	12 <sup>th</sup> January 2026 – 24 <sup>th</sup> January 2026
3.	<b>Activity during the period</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>On 6/01/2026, Savio Club Animators had a one-day training at Holy Cross parish, the facilitator of the day was Br. John. The topics were <b>safe guarding and preventive system of Don Bosco</b>. Don Bosco believed that Education should be an act of love not punishment there for he introduced the preventive system, built on three pillar that is reason, religion and loving-kindness. Don Bosco didn't wait for a fault to punish but he sought to prevent the wrong doing by surrounding the young people with care, guidance and moral example. He believed that when young people feel loved and trusted, they respond with responsibility and openness to growth. The system which Br. John used, was projecting notes and examples from his laptop and later on he will explain each point, discussion was open to everybody.</li> <li>We began registration for the new Savio Club learners as from 12/01/2026 to 23/01/2026 in all our <b>nine centres</b> and the requirement for a learner to be registered were: manifest, accompanied with a parent or guardian during registration, born between 2014 – 2018, should have a report card from the school, for the previous year, should be in grade two and the learner should be between age 8yr – 12 yr.</li> </ul>

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4.	<b>Challenges faced</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• During registration turn up in some centres were very high, except in Holy Cross and Guadalupe where the turn up were low.</li> <li>• During registration, majority of new learners didn't have report cards and that made the process to be difficult because it was hard to tell if the learner is in grade two or not. But we requested them to come with a note from the school, showing that they're in grade two.</li> <li>• One Savio Club Animator didn't report back to work and there is no communication from him, about his whereabouts that is Achuil Bol Achuil from Guadalupe.</li> </ul>
5.	<b>Plans for the next two weeks</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Transportation of refreshments to their respective centres.</li> <li>• Visiting the nine centres to supervise learning progress.</li> <li>• First week, the learners will be given orientation. The animators will explain to them about the arrival and departure time, how to groom when coming to Savio Club, the rules of Savio Club, story to St. Dominic Savio and teach them the evening prayers.</li> <li>• Second week, the learners will be taught alphabets, consonants, vowels both in English and Kiswahili, revisiting Savio Club rules, Story to Dominic Savio and the evening prayers.</li> <li>• Announcing the vacant position in Guadalupe for Christians to apply.</li> </ul>

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		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Interviewing the applicants, for the Savio Club animator's position in Guadalupe.</li> <li><b>Sorting learners</b>, from the seven centres which have high population than expected, the <b>criteria to be used is eliminating those ones who are 13 years and above, when the number is still high we will sort it according to family, nationality and gender, whereby if we have registered three learners from the same family, we will have to eliminate one</b> and another criteria is by balancing the gender and nationalities. By the end of January, we will have final numbers. Those ones who will be eliminated and they have qualified to be in Savio Club, we will put them in a waiting list just in case we have any drop out.</li> <li>Replacing those learners who were on the waiting list and showing more interest in learning, with those Savio Club learners who have drop out.</li> </ul>
