1.	Project Name of the programme	<i>Savio Club – Educational support for children</i>
2.	Reporting period	9 th February 2026 – 21 st February 2026
3.	Activity during the period	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visiting the nine centres to supervise learning progress. • Transportation of refreshments to their centres. • On 10/02/2026 we interviewed the applicants from Holy Cross, Guadalupe, Mary Help of Christians and St. Anthony of Padua. We were able to get animators from only three centres, that is Holy Cross, Guadalupe and Mary help of Chrstians. • We recruited animators from three centres and the recruits are Veronica Yohana Alamin for Holy Cross, Gatgong Ley for Mary Help of Christians and Peter Kuol Ajuot for Guadalupe. • On 9/02/2026 we procured 265 cartoons of biscuit and 254 cartoons of milk. • First week, the learners were taught combination of letters to give sound, construction of two and three letter words using consonants and vowels, kuunganisha sauti na vokali kisha kuunda maneno ya Kiswahili yenye maneno mawili na tatu, the creation story. • Second week, the learners were taught

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		<p>how to pronounce two and three letter words. The uses of different rooms in the house. kuunganisha sauti na irabu kisha kuunda maneno ya Kiswahili. Number concept and the story about the birth of Jesus. The grade three's will be taught combination of blended consonants like pl, bl, sh, and construction of words using them, healthy habit to be practise in daily life, maana ya vitenzi na vinyume vyake, addition of three digit numbers with carrying forward and the story about Namaan.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dividing the classes, grade two's to be learning separately from the grade three's. • Announcing to the Christians the savio club animators' positions for them to apply.
4.	Challenges faced	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lack of sitting benches at St. Dominic Savio, they are sitting on stones. • Lack of qualified applicants from St. Anthony of Padua. The challenge was not knowing how to communicate either in Kiswahili or English. • More learners are coming to be registered in some centres.

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		<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Visiting the nine centre to supervise learning progress.• First week, the grade two's will be taught combination of sounds to form two and three letter words, personal items (what is personal item, how we should use, clean and care for them), kuunganisha silabi ili kuunda maneno ya Kiswahili, writing numbers in figure and words as from 51 -100 and the story about the baptism of Jesus and the grade three's will be taught construction of sentences using the blended consonants ,oral hygiene (common problems related to the teeth and ways of dealing with them),msamiati wa adabu na heshima katika mazugumzo,subtraction of three digit numbers with and without borrowing and the story Moses and the burning bush.• Second week, the grade two's will be taught Greetings in different situation and times, oral hygiene (things we do that are good for our teeth, things we do that harm our teeth and how many times should we brush our teeth), msamiati wa nyumbani, addition of two digit numbers without carry forward and the story of Jesus calling his disciples. The grade three's will be taught difference between present and past tense and the construction of sentences using them, classroom cleaning (reasons for classroom cleaning, materials used for cleaning and the importance of having clean class) kutumia msamiati wa nyumbani kutunga sentensi, addiction of fractional numbers and the story of
