2.	Reporting period	23 rd March 2026 – 1 st April 2026
3.	Activity during the period	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visiting the centres to supervise learning progress. • Transportation of refreshments to their centres. • We procured milk 170 cartoons on 25/03/2026. • First week, all learners will do end of term one exams. Grade two's will do theirs same as grade three's. The exams will be done any in nine centres, excluding St. Anthony of Padua. The learners at St. Anthony of Padua will be given orientation. The animators will explain to them about the arrival and departure time, how to groom when coming to Savio Club, the rules of Savio Club, story to St. Dominic Savio and teach them the evening prayers. • Second week, the grade two's and grade three's did revision for the previous exams. The learners at St. Anthony of Padua, will be taught alphabets, consonants, vowels both in English and Kiswahili, revisiting Savio Club rules, Story to Dominic Savio and the evening prayers. • Registering new learners to replace those who didn't show up from day one to date who at St. Anthony of Padua.

Lawrence, madam Lucy and all savio club animators. We introduced the new members to the group, discussed about the aims and objectives of Savio club, reminding the animators what they're suppose to do and appreciating the good work that they're doing and our expectation from them. The animators shared teaching ideas among themselves.
4.	Challenges faced	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Lack of writing materials like exercise books and pen in some centres especially in St. Anthony of Padua. Malaria outbreak which has led to absenteeism of learners during the exams period.
5.	Plans for the next two weeks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Transportation of refreshments to their respective centres. Visiting the centres to supervise learning progress. First week, all learners and animators from the nine centres will break for April holiday as from 2/04/2026 and resume back on 13/04/2026, except St. Anthony of Padua, they will be going on with the classes., The learners at St. Anthony of Padua will be taught combination of letters to give sound, construction of two and three letter words using consonants and vowels, kuunganisha sauti na vokali kisha kuunda maneno ya Kiswahili yenye maneno mawili na tatu, the creation story.

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		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Second week, the grade two's will be taught how to write and read two and three letter word and grade three's will reading storybooks and will be taught how to answer questions after reading stories. The learners at St. Anthony of Padua will be taught how to pronounce two and three letter words. The uses of different rooms in the house. kuunganisha sauti na irabu kisha kuunda maneno ya Kiswahili. Number concept and the story about the birth of Jesus.
