3.	<b>Activity during the period</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Visiting the centers to supervise learning progress.</li> <li>• Transportation of refreshments to their respective centers.</li> <li>• We procured milk 296 boxes and 250 boxes biscuits on 4/05/2026.</li> <li>• First week, the grade two's were taught days, weeks and months of the year, basic taste of foods, sehemu za mwili, multiplication of one digit number and the fruits of the holy spirit. The grade three's will be taught collective noun, kitchen garden, vihusishi, clock face, the bible and the importance of reading the bible.</li> <li>• Second week, the grade two's were taught singular and plural the words that in plural ends with 's', ways of re-using water and soap at home, matumizi ya ako na enu katika sentensi, teach different types of shapes in the surrounding and the call of Samuel. The grade three's will be taught about adjective: what is adjective and how it's used, proper storage and handling of cooked and uncooked food, nyakati: wakati uliopita, wakati uliopo na wakati ujao, continue teaching about time and the story about Elisha and the boys and lesson learnt from the story.</li> </ul>

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• First week, St. Anthony of Padua were taught home vocabulary items found at home and their uses, personnel hygiene and the items used to clean them, siku za wiki, subtraction of one and two digit numbers without borrowing and the story of Jesus calling the twelve disciples.</li> <li>• The second week, St. Anthony of Padua were taught different colors in the surrounding, sources and uses of water, vifaa vinavyopatikana darasani, addition of two digit numbers with carrying forward and the story of Jesus feeding 5000 people.</li> <li>• Reading of storybooks daily for one hour both English and Kiswahili. Assisting those ones, who still don't know how to write and read even a single word.</li> <li>• Issuing storybooks to St. Anthony of Padua, both English and Kiswahili.</li> <li>• Resignation of Joseph Maniratabara from St. Dominic Savio due to some personnel issues and sickness.</li> <li>• Replacing the vacant position at St. Dominic Savio by interviewing the applicants.</li> <li>• Recruiting one animator from the applicants who qualified for the position, the name of the animator is Honore Manishimwe .</li> </ul>
