Activity during the period	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visiting the centers to supervise learning progress. • Transportation of refreshments to their respective centers. • We procured milk 290 boxes and 253 boxes biscuits on 12/06/2026. • First week, the grade two's were taught good eating habit, matumizi ya hawa, huyu, hili an hizi katika sentensi ,addition and subtraction of mixed sum and how to be a good neighbour .The grade three's will be taught food etiquette ,division of length both in metre and centimetre and the story of David and Goliath. • Second week, the grade two's were taught taught how to read and write simple sentences and grade three's will be taught how to answer questions after reading a story and reading of storybook both English and Kiswahili. • First week, St. Anthony of Padua were taught, re-using of water and soap, matumizi ya - ako na - enu katika sentensi, multiplication of two digit number and the story of Samuel. The grade three's were taught, oral hygiene, matumizi ya adabu njema katika mazungumzo, subtraction of three digit numbers without borrowing and the story of Moses and burning bush.

The grade three's were taught past and present tense, classroom cleaning, kutunga sentensi kutumia msamiati wa nyumbani and the story of Jonah. • Reading of storybooks daily for one hour both English and Kiswahili. Assisting those ones, who still don't know how to write and read even a single word in all the ten centres. • Learners shifting from one centre to the others due to relocation of parents.
