3.	Activity during the period	• Visiting the centers to supervise learning progress. • Transportation of refreshments to their respective centers. • First week, the grade two's were taught possessive noun ,good eating habit,umoja na wingi wa sentensi ukitumia msamiati wa nyumbani/shuleni/darasani,addition of three digit numbers and miraculous catching of fish.The grade three's will be taught verbs,safety in food storage,kukanusha sentensi kwa wakati uliopita/uliopo/ujao,division of numbers in story forms and the story of prodigal son. • Second week, the grade two's, continue learning possessive noun,safety handling of cooked food,matumizi ya vizuri na vibaya katika sentensi,different lines and meaning of trust and obedience to God and our parents .The grade three's will continue learning verb both base and action verb,continue learning safety in food storage,msamiati wa majina ya miezi,continue learning division of numbers in story form and christian community • First week,St.Anthony of Padua were taught,e animals and their young ones both domestic and wild,food that should be taken with school going children in

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		the locality,kuandika vifungu vinavyojumuishs hiki na hivi katika kuimarisha mawasiliano,repeating multiplication of one to two digit numbers and the ways of thanking God .The grade three's will be taught adjective,proper handling of cooked and uncooked food and home and it's importance,nyakati uliopita,uliopo na ujao,continue learning about time and story of Elisha and the boys. • The second week,St.Anthony of Padua grade two's were taught,people and their profession,different types of fruits and vegetables,maumbo tofauti tofauti,place value of numbers and the story of Abel and Cain.The grade three's will be taught adjective both comparative and superlative,how to care for toilet/latrine,sauti mbili zinazotamkwa pamoja kisha kuunda maneno,addiction and subtraction of length and respecting the elders. • Reading of storybooks daily for one hour both English and Kiswahili. Assisting those ones, who still don't know how to write and read even a single word in all the ten centre. • Kunda Said from Guadalupe resigning for being Savio Club animator,because he is going back to school in Canada. • Recruiting new animator in Guadalupe, that's Ngoti Al-min Tutu.
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4.	Challenges faced	• Malaria outbreak which has led to learners absenteeism. • Lack of water in some places, making sustaining learners in centre for five days hard. • Relocation of parents, making learners to drop out from Savio Club.
5.	Plans for the next two weeks	• Transportation of refreshments to their respective centers. • Visiting the centers to supervise learning progress. • First week, the grade two's will be taught, possessive pronoun in singular and plural form, body hygiene, usafi wa mwili, currency and family both nuclear and extended and grade three's using but to join two sentences, water pollution, matumizi ya (herufi kubwa, komateta, alama ya mshanga, alama ya mabano) katika sentensi, multiplication of numbers in story form. • Second week, the grade two's will learn vocabulary, waste disposal in the classroom, matumizi ya herufi kubwa katika sentensi, continue learning about currency and helpfulness in relation to the story of Jesus at the wedding in Cana and the grade three's will be taught the uses of where, when and why in the sentence, food & fitness, kusoma hadithi fupi kisha kujibu maswali, continue learning multiplication of numbers in story form and the story of Abraham and Isaac. • First week, St. Anthony of Padua grade two's will learn the uses of this and that in the

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		sentences,four taste of food,msamiati wa ukoo,addition of fraction numbers and story of Jesus walking in the water and the grade three’s will continue learning adjectives both comparative and superlative forms,different types of food groups in the locality,vitendawili ,multiplication of length and the story of David and Goliath. • The second week,St.Anthony of Padua grade two’s, will be different color & shapes in the surrounding,good eating habit,matumizi ya huu,hili na hawa katika sentensi,addition & subtraction of mixed numbers and about who is a neighbour and the grade three’s will be taught conjunctions,food etiquette,me thali,division of both centimeter & metre and how to care for the environment as God’s creation. • Reading of storybooks one hour everyday both Kiswahili and English.Assisting those ones, who still don’t know how to write and read even a single word in all the ten centers.
