2.	Reporting period	24 th August 2026 – 5 th September 2026
3.	Activity during the period	• Visiting the centers to supervise learning progress. • Savio Club resumed back from August holiday on 24/08/2026. • First week, the learners from all the ten centers did revision for the previous exams in all the five subject. • Second week,grade two learners were taught how to write dictation ,personal items uses and reasons of keeping them clean,msamiati wa mnyama nimpendaye,division of numbers and msamiati wa mnyama nimpendaye and grade three were taught how to write dictation of words,common accidents and first aid matumizi ya kiulizi katika sentensi, subtration of currency and matumizi ya kiulizi katika sentensi . • The second week,St.Anthony of Padua grade two's were taught how to write dictation,body hygiene and the importance of body hygiene,usafi wa mwili na umuhimu wake,kenyan currency and the family and grade three's were taught how to write dictation,water pollution the causes and effects of water pollution,matumizi ya herufi kubwa ,alama ya maswali,nukta,alama ya mshangao na alama ya mabano katika

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		sentensi,multiplication of two & three digit number in story form and the story of the call of Abram. • We held our meeting on 5/09/2026 at Holy Cross parish and the main agenda of the meeting was to analyse the end of term two results and ways of improving our performance . Way of improving our performance is by encouraging the learners to be present in the centre at least four days a week ,not reporting late to the centre and teaching them how to read the question and understanding it first before answering. All animators were present and the meeting was chaired by Madam Lucy. • Distributed exercise books to five centers,we gave three exercise to each learner,book 2 single ruled and one square line. • Learner transferring from one centre to the other due to relocation of the family. • Repeating the topics ,which we have covered and it wasn't well understood by the students.
4.	Challenges faced	• Lack of water in some places, more especially in Kalobeyei settlement, leading to absenteeism/late coming of learners. • Drop out of some learners.
5.	Plans for the next two weeks	● Visiting the centers to supervise learning progress. ● Transportation of refreshments to their respective centers.

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		● First week, the grade two's will be taught construction of sentence using simple words,ways of re-using soap and water,matumizi ya herufi kubwa katika sentensi,subtraction of two digit number with and without borrowing and the gift of the holy spirit.The grade three's will be taught the uses of was and were in the sentence,water pollution the causes and the effects,matumizi ya hii,hili na haya katika sentensi,addition of length in metre and the ten commandments. ● Second week,the grade two's will be taught animals and their young ones,matumizi ya hiki na hivi katika sentensi,four basic taste of different foods,addition of numbers with carry forward and without and the gifts of the holy spirit.The grade three's will be taught opposite of words,safety in food storage,matumizi ya alama ya kiulizi katika sentensi ,clock face and christian values and moral values. ● First week,St.Anthony of Padua grade two's will be taught possessive pronoun in singular and plural,waste disposal in school and at home,matumizi ya herufi kubwa katika sentensi,addition of numbers with and without carry forward ,helpfulness with relation to wedding in canaan.The grade 3 will be taught the uses of where and why in the sentences,food and body fitness,kusoma hadithi fupi kisha kujibu maswali,multiplication of numbers in word forms and the story of Abraham and Isaac. ● Second week,St.Anthony of Padua grade 2 will be taught possessive pronoun both singular and plural,personal items uses and reasons
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		for keeping them clean,msamiati wa mnyama nimpendaye division of simple numbers and the story of Abel and Cain .The grade 3 will be taught the uses of when and who in the sentence,common accidents and basic first aid,matumizi ya alama ya kiulizi katika sentensi,substarction of currency and the 12 tribes of isralietes ● Distribution of exercise books to the remaining five centers.	
6.	Observations	● After the meeting with the animator I observed that, same cause of results drop out in almost all the centers and the causes were absenteeism of learners , late coming and not reading the questions to the grade three’s during the exams as it was before. ● Lack of water and food in Kakuma Refugee camp and Kalobeyei settlement has affected more learners in their performance. ● During marking of exams the teachers were strict in spellings.
